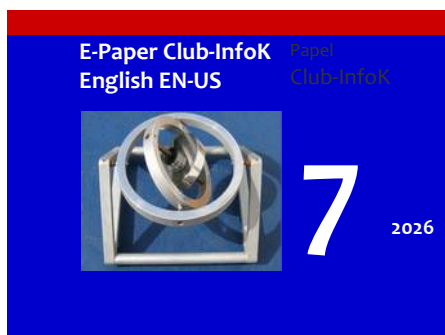

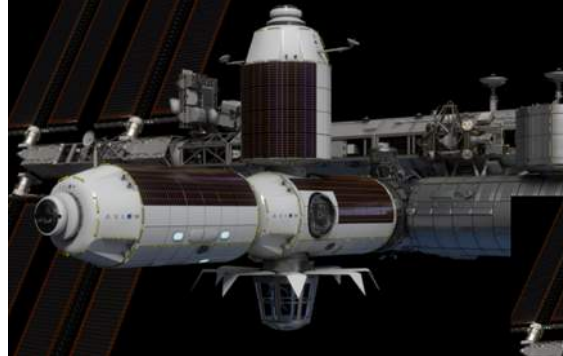

Discover Europe off the beaten path

Everyone knows when and where **the first railway ran in England**. But do they know it for Germany and **Central Germany**?

Most Western Europeans don't even know that Central Germany isn't anywhere in Eastern Europe, a Cold War misconception.

The first railway in Central Germany ran in April 1837 on a section of what would later become the **Leipzig-Dresden Railway**.

Leipzig and **Althen** were connected, and in 1839 there was then **the first German long-distance railway**.

So, not in West Germany!

Civil Railway Peru - Stories

i-Cosmos (America) – you've probably already heard in the Americas region that Peru is planning a high-speed train heading north. But there used to be a train heading north, and relatively unknown in Europe is the story of some of the labor forces that were involved. Even today, families with German surnames are said to live in this regional area; sometimes they no longer speak German, but they keep the German name.

At some point in the second half of the 19th century, the planning of the Ferrocarril de Lima a Huacho railway also began, and the actual route then ran north of Lima from the port of Ancón (picture, now part of Lima) through Huacho (the regional capital) and further on to Barranca.

Peru, mountains, and no swimming in the Pacific?

Adventure trips - **i-Cosmos** – The Inca region near Machu Picchu is very popular, but Peru is huge, and most visitors don't know the full history of the Inca era's peak, where they supposedly made state-proven 'excursions all the way to Polynesia.' Not individually, but allegedly in aircraft carrier strength of around **20,000** people. By the way, that place is now a French island territory.

We'd better show the beach at Barranca, which in the 19th century was the final stretch of the railway over Huacho near Lima. You've got a beach and even some famous figures on the mountain. Peru's railway history, **Ancón harbor** – Huacho - **Barranca**.

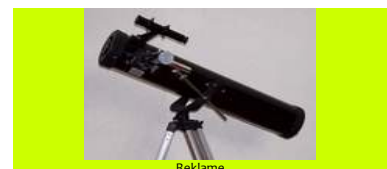
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
